### Lynn Goldstein - Judge

A fine arts graduate of West Virginia University, Goldstein was employed for seventeen years as a graphic designer and illustrator in the Washington, D.C. area before following her passion for painting. Her former focus on graphic design provides a solid compositional understanding in her fine artwork today.

Goldstein has enjoyed painting many varied subjects, but her current concentration is the landscape, with a particular focus on trees. Using pastels as her medium of choice, Goldstein layers color upon color to create luminous passages in her pieces.

As a member of the Pastel Society of America and a signature member of the Maryland Pastel Society, she also served on the board of directors. Goldstein has her studio and is a juried artist at the Workhouse Art Center at Lorton. Her work has received numerous national awards and has been exhibited in juried shows across the country. Her work is represented at the Washington Street Gallery in Lewisburg, West Virginia. Most recently, Goldstein's work was profiled in the August 2009 issue of the Pastel Journal magazine, which also included an article that Goldstein wrote to encourage artists to look at their work from a different perspective.

A popular teacher, Goldstein received an outstanding instructor award from Fairfax County, Virginia in 2006. Goldstein teaches drawing, portraiture and pastels to adults in Fairfax County and has also taught workshops in the mid-Atlantic area. Additionally, Goldstein has taught workshop classes at the Smithsonian National Portrait Gallery in Washington, D.C. where she also regularly volunteers her time as a docent.

**ELIGIBILITY - Four (4) original works in any media - painting, mixed-media, sculpture, photography - image may not to exceed 8" in any direction.** Works that have won awards in prior LRA shows or have been accepted into LRA juried shows are not eligible. Site restrictions prohibit sexually explicit (nudity) or violent themes.

**SALES -** Herndon Art Space Gallery will retain a 25% sales commission on all sales including sales up to 30 days after the exhibit closes which are a direct result of this exhibit. Work will be sold at the price listed in the entry form unless markets Not for Sale (NFS).

**LIABILITY -** Artists exhibit all work at their own risk. The LRA and the Herndon Art Space Gallery are not responsible or liable for damage, theft or loss of an individual's work from any cause whatsoever.

**AGREEMENT -** All accepted work must remain for the duration of the show. LRA reserves the right to photograph work for publicity and use on the LRA website. LRA is not responsible for works left after the pick-up dates following the close of the exhibit. Submission of any entry constitute understanding and agreement with all of the conditions set forth in this prospectus.

**INSTALLATION -** All work must be able to be hung on the wall and ready for installation with proper hanging devices. Screw eyes installed close to the top edge at the back of the work is most desirable for this location since the hanging system requires hanging by fishing line. LRA reserves the right to refuse work that is improperly presented or unsafe to hang. No clips front or back will be accepted. All work must be identified with the artist's name, phone number, title of work, medium and price. **NOTE: Please adhere to the frame requirements. Judges are critical about framing...keep frames simple. Also, work that has wet paint will not be accepted.**

**PRESS PROMOTION -** The following are the instructions and guidelines for submitting material for press promotion to the local newspapers. This is an excellent opportunity for you to promote your artistic contribution to this LRA/Herndon Art Space Gallery exhibit. **Your submitted images for jurying will be retained to use for publicity.
